John's Jogs: LET FREEDOM RING IN 2018

As we celebrate our nation's independence, many of our most cherished freedoms are under attack. The first two articles of the "Bill of Rights" or the first two amendments to the constitution are under attack today. These two articles are the firewall of protection of our freedoms. If we lose these two articles we lose our freedom!

ARTICLE I – "Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion or prohibiting the free exercise thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech, or of the press; or the right of the people peaceably to assemble, and to petition the Government for a redress of grievances."

ARTICLE II – "A well regulated Militia, being necessary to the security of a free State, the right of the people to keep and bear Arms, shall not be infringed."

Note that Article I makes five areas of freedom: 1) Congress cannot establish a

religion. 2) Congress cannot make a law to prohibit the free exercise of religion.

3) Congress cannot make a law to stop you freely speaking out on any subject.

4) Congress cannot make a law to stop the

freedom of the press and 5) Congress cannot make a law to prevent people from assembling peaceably and redressing their grievances. These are clear statements and are the sum total the constitution says about religion.

Note that Article II makes two statements 1) For as a free state to be secure it must have a well regulated Militia and 2) The government cannot prevent the people from bearing arms. Note: The Supreme Court has upheld this article as applying nation wide – that a state or city cannot restrict personal ownership of guns to protect yourself, your family or your home.

Article I guarantees security of our religious freedom and Article II provides the strength to protect Article I. Article I is

under attack from the ACLU and others using the "Separation of Church and State" statement of T. Jefferson (which has nothing to do with the constitution). Article II is under attack from basically the same group plus others trying to remove all guns from society which would only leave guns in the hands of criminals.

The real danger is that the opponents of religion and guns will not use the Amendment process to achieve their goals but rely on unelected federal judges to find meanings in the constitution beyond what these clear articles say and the Supreme Court is on a teeter-totter equilibrium with a 5-4 decision on most important issues. As you vote at all levels of government keep this in your mind in any election year.

Stop and reverently give a prayer of thanks for our freedom today!
