Lindberg flew across the Atlantic, Babe Ruth hit 60 home runs, and I was born. I was born before television, penicillin, Polio shots, frozen foods, Xerox, plastic, contact lens, Frisbees and the pill. I was born before radar, credit cards, split atoms, laser beams, and ball point pens, before panty hose, dishwashers, clothes dryers, electric blankets, air conditioners, drip dry clothes, and before man walked on the moon.

We were married first and then lived together (how quaint). Closets were for clothes, not "coming out of." Bunnies were small rabbits and rabbits were not Volkswagens. Designer jeans were scheming girls named Jean or Jeanne, and having a meaningful relationship meant getting along with your cousins. I was

born before "gay rights" in fact gay meant (happy, pleasant, fun) before computer dating, dual careers, day-care centers, and nursing homes. I was grown & growing older before FM radio, tape decks, electric typewriters, artificial hearts, word processors, yogurt and guys wearing ear rings. A "chip" meant a piece of wood; hardware meant hardware and software wasn't even a word.

In 1940, "made in Japan" meant junk and the term "making out" referred to how you did on your exam. Pizza, McDonalds and instant coffee were unheard of. There were 5 & 10 cent stores where you bought things that cost 5 & 10 cents. For a nickel you could ride the street car, make a phone call, buy a coke, or enough stamps to mail

a letter and two post cards. You could buy a new Chevy Coupe for \$600 and drive it for 11 cents a gallon gas.

In my day cigarette smoking was fashionable, grass was mowed, Coke was a drink and pot was something in which you cooked. AIDS were helpers. I certainly was not born before the difference between sexes was discovered, but surely before sex change. We were the last generation that was dumb enough to believe you needed a husband to have a baby. No wonder we are so confused and there is such a generation gap.
