John’s Jogs: SUMMER SERIES PROGRAM

I should have written this before the “Series” began, but we had “Senior Day” then “Father’s Day” so I want to explain how the program came into being.

Our Theme for the Summer Series is: “THE NAMES OF GOD.”

In searching for the names, I discovered a book in my library authored by a former Champions’ member, Casandra Martin, and published by 21st Century Christian. We decided to use the names she had selected. She made an introduction to her book which I can’t improve on as an introduction to our “Summer Series:”

“The study of the names and titles of God is a study of the nature and character of God. The titles and descriptions of God as revealed throughout the Bible provide us with rich layers of meaning and insight into the heart of the God who loved us so. We will see His peace quiet our troubled spirits; His faithfulness covers our rebellion; His protection blankets our fear; His healing soothes our deepest pain.”

Casandra also said, “Our hearts hunger to know God better. We ache to see His glory, be touched by His grace, and experience the peace of His presence. Opening our Bibles, we discover that God longs to make His heart known to those who love Him. He passes by and reveals His glory every time we come to His Word with open hearts.

God’s heart is revealed through His names. Throughout His relationships with His people, God open His arms and shows His children who He is, inviting us to explore His nature and character. Knowing His names allows us to catch a glimpse of all He longs to do in our lives. Grow closer to God as He reveals Himself through the study of His names. Pick up your Bible, stand on the mountain, and ask, “God, pass by me.”
