## John's Jogs: Remembering October 12, 1946

Friday would have been our 72<sup>nd</sup> anniversary so I'll share some of my reminiscing with you. Spring 1946 I'm stationed in Bainbridge, Md. Naval base about 30 miles from Lancaster, Penn., a favorite weekend liberty town. We're on a bus to the local roller rink when a good looking girl appears and I said to my buddy, "that's my girl tonight." On the rink she was an excellent skater and I was on the floor most of the night in front of her, but it worked. Interestingly, we never went skating again.

By the end of summer 1946 we were ready (we thought) to get married. I had \$15 and Ramona had \$8 and my Navy pay was \$62 per month. So on October 12, 1946, in the home of Ramona's Lutheran Pastor we said our, I do's, and spent our one night honeymoon in the local hotel. I was able to get a room for us in the barracks on base and we cooked on a hot plate. The room cost \$28 per month and she could buy food in the commissary. We had it made! I had every night and every other week-end off

and I could walk to work.

We Had it Made! For two months. For nearly a year before we married I had tried everything possible to go to sea to no avail. But now early December 1946, I'm in the Philadelphia Naval vard waiting assignment to a ship. I'm assigned to the USS Leyte, named for the Battle of Leyte, where my best friend's brother was killed a year earlier. In January 1947 we anchored in Norfolk, Virginia, to load ammunition. Ramona came to meet me there. In the liberty boat going to shore the choppy icy waters bounced over the side soaking my blue uniform. When my uniform dried it was white with salt. Our couple days together were great. We wrote frequently for the next year but the letters would arrive in groups much less frequently. I developed a cartoon character named "Qualls the Sailor" for my letters to her.

In February 1947 I got the worst sunburn of my life in Trinidad. On April 3rd we started our

first Mediterranean Cruise and returned to Quonset Point, R.I. on June 9<sup>th</sup>. Again Ramona met the ship – I could see her on the dock from the flight deck. We were able to spend a couple days together in Providence. In July, I was in Newfoundland about to freeze and on July 30 we started our Second Mediterranean Cruise and returned November 19,1947. In Quonset Point waiting for discharge on Dec 3<sup>rd</sup>, I decided to hitchhike to Lancaster for the weekend. I caught 21 rides including a motorcycle across Philadelphia.

Ramona had proved herself to be a worthy helpmate for she surprised me by having obtained and furnished an apartment for us for \$45 a month including heat. I still have the little bookcase she bought in my living room. Later we bought a 1940 floor standing RCA Victor radio which I still have. It provided many hours of entertainment in our early years together. Have to stop – out of space.
