John's Jogs: The Coming of the Holy Spirit

In the Gospel of John chapters 14, 15, 16, we have the last recorded discourse of Jesus. It was delivered on the night He was betrayed, after He had instituted the Lord's Supper. His audience consisted of His 12 apostles. It was a good setting for a special revelation. Therefore we must understand what Jesus taught about the coming of the Holy Spirit: He was informing them that He was returning to heaven to the Father but was sending the Holy Spirit as a replacement for Himself to encourage and guide them.

Jesus gave them some facts about the promise to send the Spirit of Truth. First He will be sent from the Father (14:16). He (HS) will testify about Me (Jesus) (15:26). According to 16:7, Jesus said, "If I go, I will send Him (the Holy Spirit) to you." So He's to be sent when Jesus went

back to heaven. Jesus told the apostles that unlike Him, God was sending the Helper to be with them from then on. He was being sent to carry on Jesus' work. The Helper (H.S.) would do what Jesus had done while He was with the apostles. The reference to Him as "another Helper" (14:16) implies that He would be another of the same kind doing the same thing. Jesus had provided guidance and help for the apostles during His time with them, and the Holy Spirit would provide such assistance.

The Holy Spirit would abide with the apostles (14:16,17), "He would teach them Coy Roper – Truth for Today all things, and bring to their remembrance all that Jesus said to them" (14:26). Further, the Holy Spirit would guide them into all truth. When the Holy Spirit came upon the apostles, they would be ready for the whole truth, and the Spirit would reveal it

to them. The apostles would be guided into all truth by the Holy Spirit as the Spirit testified about Jesus. Then the apostles would also testify about Christ. When the Spirit of Truth proceeds from the Father, He will testify about Me, and you will testify also, because you have been with me from the beginning (15:27). Jesus said, "He will glorify Me because it is from Me that He will receive what He will make known to you." Because of the Holy Spirit's testimony about Jesus' teachings, Jesus Christ would be glorified.
