THE CHAMPIONS SPIRIT

Living Guilt Free

What does it mean to live without guilt? Should we have no remorse at all for sin, hurting others, or causing damage or pain in someone else's life? When we talk about living without guilt, we are talking about living without the guilt of our past because of God's forgiveness. We still have Godly sorrow in terms of sin and its consequences, but we don't have to carry guilt about our past in terms of our relationship with God.

"No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us." This verse is the starting point for our fourth lesson in our Neighborhood Bible Studies. In context, this verse is dealing with God's love and how it overcomes anything we might face in life (tribulation, distress, persecution, famine, danger, death, etc. Rm. 8:35,38). The word "conqueror" is a military term relating to victory. Paul says that we are more than victors through God's love. God's love can overcome anything we face in life, and it can overcome our past.

It is interesting how we can carry around guilt like a heavy burden because we have trouble understanding and accepting God's forgiveness. I guess there are several reasons why this can be the case. Whatever the reason might be, at the heart is Satan trying to convince us that God's grace and forgiveness is not enough. Dan Winkler, in his book on forgiveness, says there are three steps we must be willing to take in order to overcome guilt and fully accept God's forgiveness.

- Accept God's love the story of the prodigal son demonstrates God's love and forgiveness (Lk. 15:11-32).
- Believe God's promises you and I can know with confidence we are saved (Rm. 8:1; 2 Pet. 1:8-11; 1 Jn. 1:7).
- Trust God's grace David, in the Old Testament, and Paul, in the New Testament, serve as two great reminders of the power of God's grace.

God's love, grace, and forgiveness are truly amazing. The parable of the prodigal son demonstrates all three of these elements in a beautiful way. Dan made the point that maybe we should rename this parable "The Parable of the Colossal Father." Our Colossal Father feels compassion for us, He has taken us when we were dead and lost, and He has made us alive again. That is colossal love!
