A View of the Bible?

A Gallup Poll about Americans and their view of the Bible was released in May of 2017. The title of the article published in Gallup News was "Record Few Americans Believe Bible Is Literal Word of God." The highlights of the research can be summarized with the following three points:

24% of people believe the Bible is the literal Word of God (the lowest in Gallup's 40year trend).

26% of people view the Bible as secular stories, fables, and legends as recorded by man (up from 21% in 2014).

47% (the largest segment) still think the Bible is the inspired Word of God.

These numbers beg us to ask ourselves the question, what is the Bible to us? I believe most, if not all of us, would say that it is the inspired Word of God. Maybe the more relevant issue for us as Christians is, do we view it as a "rulebook" or God speaking to us out of love and seeking what's best for us?

Consider with me some of the following points made in Scripture:

All Scripture, every single word, is "breathed out by God" – 2 Tim. 3:16

Scripture is "living," and "active." It can expose our thoughts and intentions – Heb. 4:12

It provides light to help us navigate this world and enjoy life more fully – Ps. 119:105

It can help us live a life of purity – Ps. 119:9

It provides refreshment and can make us wise – Ps. 19:7

It provides wisdom and understanding – Prov. 4:5

It will last forever – Isa. 40:8

This list is not meant to be all inclusive. It is my hope that these verses will remind us that God loves us and wants us to live a life that has purpose, provides fulfillment, and draws us closer to Him. The Bible is God's method of communicating with us. He has given it to us because He loves us and wants what is best for us. Let's make sure we spend time with Him on a regular basis listening to Him talk to us.
