John's Jogs: VETERANS DAY - TOMORROW

Here is my annual Veterans Day article: Armistice Day was celebrated as the anniversary of the cessation of hostilities in World War I (Nov. 11, 1918) and of the signing of an armistice between the allies and Germany. Immediately after the war, Nov. 11 was set aside in the U. S., Great Britain, and France as a day of remembrance for those who had given their lives in the war and was generally called Armistice Day.

After World War II it was recognized as a day of tribute to the dead of that conflict as well as World War I. In Canada it came to be known as Remembrance Day. In Great Britain the Sunday nearest November 11 was proclaimed as Remembrance Sunday and was devoted to honoring the dead of both wars.

After the Korean War President Dwight Eisenhower signed a bill June 1, 1954, designating November 11th as Veterans Day and proclaiming it as an occasion for honoring veterans of all wars. It is usually observed with parades, speeches and the placing of floral tributes on the graves of servicemen. In the U. S. group naturalization ceremonies have come to be an important part of the day's activities. Special services are held at Arlington National Cemetery and at similar shrines in other countries. *(Encyclopedia Britannica)*

The term Veteran denotes a person who has completed a term of service in the armed forces and returned to civilian life. Veterans are usually thought of as persons who have served their country in times of war either as combatants or noncombatants. By the 1960s in the U. S. there were 22,000,000 veterans, roughly one-eighth of the total population.




